## **Rising 2<sup>nd</sup> Grade Summer Reading**

During the summer, students at Immaculate Conception are expected to read three books, one assigned book and 2 of his/her choosing. Students should be prepared to take Accelerated Reader (AR) tests on the books when they return to school in the fall.

The required book for 2nd grade is *Herbie Jones Sails Into Second Grade*, by Suzy Kline. When class resumes in the fall, the 2<sup>nd</sup> grade will do a study on this novel. Students should also choose 2 other books to read for the summer. The only requirements are that the book must be at least 1<sup>st</sup>-2<sup>nd</sup> grade reading level and have an AR test. To check to see if a book has an AR test, visit this site: <http://www.arbookfind.com>. This site will also tell you the book's reading level. Students will take an AR test on the book when they return to school in the fall.



# Summer Fun Math and Language Arts

## **Rising 2<sup>nd</sup> Grade Summer Math and Language Arts (IXL)**

The purpose of Immaculate Conception's Summer Math and Language Arts Program is to encourage students to review and practice skills learned during the school year.

Students are expected to participate by practicing online on IXL. Each student is required to complete one hour a week on practicing math and 30 minutes a week on language arts. Please have your child practice a variety of skills.

Your child's homeroom teacher will check the reports when school returns in August. Your child will need to have a total of 10 hours completed in math and 5 hours completed in language arts. The first day of school is August 10, 2016. All work needs to be completed by Friday, August 5<sup>th</sup>.
